REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT COMES TO KENTUCKY, FINALLY: "FREE AT LAST!"

In a truly revolutionary move, the Kentucky State Senate has overthrown its long-time, autocratic, pro-abortion leadership, and elected a Senate President supported by a coalition of Democrats and Republicans, committed to the true democratic process of representative government.

By way of background, as is frequently the case, we need to go back a good little time. The reader needs to review our several past issues, specifically Dec. 1996 and previous issues, concerning the election of the Senate seat from Kenton County. For quite a few years, the Pro-Life Movement has been languishing, nationally as well as in Kentucky, by reason of "softness" of some Pro-Lifers on politicians. Whatever else may be said, this has not been a problem of NKRTL. In 1992, **Sen. Joe Meyer of Kenton County (D)** acquiesced to the pressure of the pro-abortion Democratic leadership in the Senate, over the strong protestations of NKRTL, and "played the game" of political correctness, voting again to keep Pro-Life bills bottled up in committee, including one upon which he was the prime sponsor. In 1994, NKRTL supported a strong campaign against his re-election, and in fact defeated him in his home county of Kenton, but he was successfully re-elected by a very slim majority since he won in Campbell County with the complicity of a former Pro-Lifer, **Rep. Bill Donnermeyer (D)**.

Meyer had drawn himself (as Chairman of the Senate State Government Committee, the committee charged with redistricting for elections) the most comfortable seat that he could, cutting across 3 counties, and including only the hard core Democratic districts along the river. This flagrant violation of the Kentucky Constitution, which requires that senate seats be constituted as nearly as possible along county lines, was held unconstitutional by the Kentucky Supreme Court, in a lawsuit filed and practiced by **Attorney Joe Fischer**, a Board member of **Greater Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky Lawyers for Life**, and therefore districts had to be redrawn. Meyer then had to comply with the Constitution and draw a district wholly within Kenton County. He drew a district as favorable as possible to himself, excluding all of the Republican areas of Kenton County — but it was not enough, as his own designed district turned him out by a dramatic proportion of 10 percentage points.

Contrary to the "amazement" of the secular press, and the pro-abortion Democratic leadership in the state, from the Governor on down, Democrat/Catholic Joe Meyer was defeated by unknown Republican/Protestant Jack Westwood in heavily Democratic/Catholic Northern Kentucky - because of abortion - "the elephant in the living room that no one wants to recognize". Meyer's pro-abortion votes were brought effectively to the conscience of the electorate, and found unacceptable.

This left the State Senate (which had been stymying all Pro-Life bills for several years with the complicit active votes of Meyer with a new membership of 18 Pro-Life Republicans, and 20 Democrats, all of whom had voted pro-abortion in the past, but there are two replacement Democrats who had defeated two incumbent pro-abortion Democrats). The volatile mix was obvious!

"Humble them, Lord!"

Interestingly enough, the Senate accepted for its Prayer/Opening on the organization day of Jan. 8, 1997, the **Rev. John Russell of Lakeside Christian Church**, pastor of the new senator from Kenton County, Jack Westwood, who, in his opening prayer, prayed to God that He would humble this body. Many think that the Lord responded favorably and promptly to this Invocation!

After the opening of the Session, **Sen. Pres. Rose**, who had presided over the Senate for a decade, promptly rapped his gavel and sought a one hour recess. Fifteen Democrats then walked out of the chamber, leaving 5 Democrats and all 18 Republicans on the Senate Floor. **Dem. Sen. Larry Saunders of Louisville** stood and noted that more than enough legislators remained on the Floor for the Senate to proceed, and another Democratic senator called for Saunders to be elected as temporary president so that the Chamber could continue its business. After some parliamentary maneuvers, Saunders was elected President, and the business of the State continued, despite the walk out of the now dissident and minority Democratic senators.

"Spin doctors" versus citizen reaction

The response naturally of the secularist/hedonist media was of course overwhelmingly negative - "Palace Coup", "Senate Chief Brokers", etc. In its usual "surface" manner, the media failed to deal with the underlying substantive issues.

But the public intuitively understood what was going on here, and applauded it, overwhelmingly. The *Kentucky Post* put a "hotline/call-in" program in place and the *Post's* ears were "burned" concerning "...a century of one party domination of our political process in Frankfort", the "good ole boy system" which has been appropriately retired by this move, etc.

Letters to the Editor of course also overwhelmingly supported this hopeful chance of return to the true democratic process of representative government: "The lesson I pray the Democrats have learned in this is that it isn't juggling districts that brings one closer to the people, but in understanding and reflecting their values. ...I believe the reason that Jack Westwood won his election is not party politics. The majority of the people of Northern Kentucky are moderate conservative, pro-life, critical of KERA and anti-consolidation. Joe Meyer's and your newspaper's positions on all of these issues are the opposite. ...The elected officials in Northern Kentucky should get this message.

Anti-consolidation, pro-life, moderate conservative, and critical of KERA. Represent your electorate on these issues or get voted out of office.”

A broader perspective on the political process

Any reasonable observer of the current scene would have to admit that this dramatic occurrence in Kentucky politics was precipitated by Meyer's defeat. One wonders how he could have been defeated, in light of his supposed overwhelming support, if one reads the secular press. The reality of course is quite to the contrary. In Meyer's October required filed report in his campaign, 86% of his itemized contribution came from outside his District, totaling almost \$42,000. Half of that came from outside of the State of Kentucky! Moreover, a third of that came from political action committees (all outside of the state). This produced a result that his total “out of district” funding was 89%!

The future??

While it is important that we follow the Biblical mandate: “place not your trust in princes”, it is truly possible that an enlightened electorate could re-awake an enlightened legislature — if not initially to the Biblical principles of unchanging, eternal truths, perhaps at least to the concept of representative government.

Hope in this respect is generated by the article by the new President, Larry Saunders, in the *Kentucky Post* article of 2/14/97: “For too long, a closed-off — clique of Senate Democratic leaders called all the shots in the Senate. They decided what bills would be voted on. They decided what bills would be killed. ...I was elected President by those formerly disenfranchised voices in a public vote on an open Floor. Finally, those voices numbered a majority. I was elected by a bipartisan group of Democrats and Republicans who knew that, whatever change, without new vision, Kentucky's Senate would never be the fully representative body the framers of the 1891 constitution envisioned, but only a fiefdom of a few. ...They want their real concerns addressed, not bottled up by a legislative leadership out of touch with the people, or just out of sorts with an honorably elected senator of whatever party. ...The Senate will be open to all views, all discussion, all debate.”

“What can one person do?”

The regular “Kentucky Report”, broadcast on **WKY TV** with journalists from all over the state, covered this dramatic Senate turn around in its Jan. 10, 1997 program. It was significant that the journalists admitted what many of the politicians and many of the newspapers were unwilling to talk about that it was “the abortion issue that started it all — drove it.” Pro-Lifers can be justifiably proud that through their painful and sacrificial advocacy, they contributed mightily to the bringing about of the most dramatic political revolution in the history of the State of Kentucky, and participated in the initial steps towards restoration of true representative government, under which the will of the people can truly be expressed through their elected representatives. If the will of the people is truly expressed, then we have every reason to be optimistic concerning the rights of the unborn.

The next time you hear someone justify their inaction with the lame excuse “I am just one person — what can I do?” you need to tell them how one election in one part of the state literally caused the house of cards to tumble down around the ears of the power brokers!

**1997 MARCH FOR LIFE:
“NO ONE CAN SERVE TWO MASTERS”**

Nellie Gray's magnificent and uncompromising organization, **The National March for Life Committee**, carried out a successful and massive peaceful protest of abortion again in Washington, DC, on Jan. 22, 1997, for the 24th year, and attracted a record 225,000 Pro-Life Americans from every state in the Nation.

When the March for Life Fund Board of Directors set the theme for this year's March "No One Can Serve Two Masters", they were thinking, President Nellie Gray tells us, "About the politician who gives lip service to the Life Principles and then follows along with the secular world's efforts to approve of intentionally killing innocent born and pre-born human beings. But, this theme also applies to the work and attitudes of public officials, doctors, lawyers, teachers, police, media, and all people operating in the name of right to life."

GOVERNMENT POWERS ATTEMPT TO EXCLUDE PRO-LIFERS FROM CLINTON'S RE-INAUGURATION

Governmental powers continue to attempt to restrict free speech rights of Pro-Lifers and treat them as "second class citizens". **Operation Rescue West** had applied for a demonstration permit on the route of the inauguration parade in Washington, DC, in January, and, even though they were the first to apply, their application was denied, by the parade authority,

and their place on the sidewalk given to the **Clinton Re-Inauguration Committee** for its use. Pro-Life attorney **Jim Henderson of American Center for Law & Justice, New Hope (Ky.) Center** filed an injunction action in the Federal District Court in Wash., DC, where the judge recognized that our free speech rights were involved, but attempted to carve out some sort of "presidential inauguration" exception. It took an emergency appeal to the Court of Appeals to restore the First Amendment Constitutional rights, and the Pro-Life demonstrators were given their position on the sidewalk, holding up the bloody evidence of what Bill Clinton has worked so hard to establish and maintain. Isn't it interesting how "liberal" some people are with respect to advancing at any cost the very recently found "right" of a woman to destroy her unborn child, and yet how "illiberal" they can be in addressing the time-honored right of freedom of expression clearly and incontestably protected in the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution?

Planned Parenthood Federation of America is the number one abortion provider in this country, and receives \$17 million per year from the U.S. government to promote abortion as birth control.

We should all be doing something about it, in complaining to our U.S. Congressmen and Senators, and our pro-abortion President, as well as letting these companies know that we are not going to buy their products, and if we are stockholders insisting that they withdraw their donations to this organized mass murderer, Planned Parenthood.

We need to study the incontestable evidence cited recently by **Fr. Kenneth Baker, S.J., President of Catholic Views Broadcasts, Inc.** Fr. Baker is the widely-respected Bible scholar who edits the widely used monthly magazine "**Homiletic and Pastoral Review**" (Fr. Baker by the way will be guest speaker in Covington on the **Authentically Catholic Speaker Series** on Monday, April 14th at the **Drawbridge Estates at 7:00 p.m.**, speaking on Biblical interpretation. The public is invited.) Viewing our troubled and unraveling society, Fr. Baker observed that a great many problems are bound, like **links in a chain**, to the sin of contraception:

- ◆ Contraception, or birth control, separates the unity of the marital act from its life-giving power. A couple using contraception takes from God the power to say when new life begins. **Link:** if an unwanted pregnancy occurs, it is likely that they will end that life with abortion.
- ◆ Many couples using birth control will find that the unity of their marriage unravels. **Link:** contraception very often leads to divorce.
- ◆ If people lose sight of God's purpose for sex, then disordered sexuality becomes widespread. **Link:** in a contracepting society, homosexuality becomes acceptable.
- ◆ Finally, in a society where children are not wanted, there are fewer workers to support the elderly. **Link:** with the respect for life gone, it becomes easy to kill the elderly and the sick with euthanasia.

Each sin in this chain has terrible consequences.

- ◆ Contraception leads to widespread promiscuity, and skyrocketing rates of sexually transmitted diseases.
- ◆ Abortion kills a baby, but is also harms a woman physically and emotionally.
- ◆ Divorce often causes great pain to the couple, but it always greatly disturbs the children.
- ◆ Homosexuality leads to great unhappiness — and to the rampant spread of AIDS.
- ◆ Euthanasia is introduced as mercy killing of the sick and elderly but it is soon applied against many other groups of people.

Each link in the chain leads logically down the slippery slope of disaster.

PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTION - STILL NOT DEAD

As you know, both Houses of Congress overwhelmingly passed a bill last year that would prohibit this savagery masquerading under the name of medicine that permits a child to be four-fifths born, leaving the head only in the womb and then a scissors is inserted to the back of the skull of this moving and living child, and the hole widened and a suction tube inserted which then suctions the brains out, and then the dead child is delivered.

The bill was vetoed by our abortion President, Bill Clinton, who argued that this procedure is necessary and is used only in third trimester abortions on babies who will die anyway, and who might thereby render their mothers infertile and incapable of delivering future children.

There has now been public admission by a leader in the abortion industry itself, what we all knew anyhow, that these representations are indeed a pack of lies! The **American Medical News** reports that **Ron Fitzsimmons, Executive Director of the National Coalition of Abortion Providers**, a major trade association of abortion providers, admits that the vast majority of partial birth abortions are performed in the 20 plus week range (late second trimester) on healthy fetuses and healthy mothers, and Fitzsimmons commented,

"The abortion rights folks know it, the anti-abortion folks know it, and so, probably, does everyone else." When he was interviewed recently on Nightline, he stated that in his testimony to the contrary on the ABC Nightline interview of 1995, he "lied through my teeth" and told his wife

the next day, "I can't do this again."

The Partial Birth Abortion Ban has been introduced again in Congress and hearings scheduled, and it is anticipated that it will be passed again by both Houses. President Clinton and his pro-abort colleagues are now trying to get ahead of the issue, by urging that they would support such legislation if it carried a "health of the mother" exception. This is simply another lie by a pro-abortion president. He full well knows that the companion case to Roe v. Wade, Doe v. Bolton decided also in 1973, extended the "health" exception for abortion to include mental anxiety, so that indeed we have open-ended abortion on demand through nine months, if there is a health exception. As usual, "slick Willy" is on top of the situation and wishes to make political capital while simultaneously maintaining his obligations to the abortion industry. Members of Congress should be urged not to permit any such exceptions, which would of course in fact destroy the effectiveness of the legislation entirely. This fact of course is well-known to the abortionists, as well as to Clinton. But if people will kill, why should we be astonished that they will lie!

The Partial Birth Abortion Ban, intact, again just passed the U.S. House by the overwhelming vote of 295 to 136. You need to write immediately to Sens. Wendell Ford and Mitch McConnell urging their support, with no exceptions!

FIRST 1997 PRO-LIFE TEST IN CONGRESS - A VICTORY FOR ABORTIONISTS

International Planned Parenthood Federation, a powerful, multi-billion dollar business whose avowed purpose is spreading abortion, birth control, and sterilization world-wide, once again will feed at the federal trough.

Presidents Reagan and Bush banned U.S. aid to overseas organizations that counseled, promoted or performed abortions. Clinton reversed this policy in a drive to ensure legal abortion on demand as a "fundamental human right".

Though complicated, basically at issue was \$385 million allocated by Congress last September for family-planning programs overseas with the stipulation that it not go to organizations that promote or perform abortion. President Clinton refused to accept the anti-abortion stipulation and threatened a veto.

Whereupon Congress capitulated with a proverbial slap on the President's wrist. Clinton could have the money in March 1997 Congress said, to give to any organization he pleased, if he could satisfy Congress by February that delaying it further would have a negative effect on overseas family planning programs.

The President horse-swinded the Congress, who barely managed to retain a clause that none of the money be spent on abortion. But so what! Organizations like IPPF will simply use our tax money to pay for family planning (i.e., birth control), which will free up its private income (no doubt some of it coming from a lucrative U.S. abortion business), to pay for abortions overseas.

The pro-aborts won by a vote of 220 to 209, and had to have for their winning margin 13 supposed Pro-Life Republicans and 8 alleged Pro-Life Democrats, all of whom claimed in their electoral campaigns to be Pro-Life (and who are certified by the score cards produced by National Right to Life Committee and the Christian Coalition to be Pro-Life). More evidence of the fatal consequences of "soft" Pro-Lifers! Incidentally, it has just been found out that National Right to Life Committee received a \$650,000.00 grant from the Dole campaign which is perhaps why it was so glowing in its classifying of Dole as a "Pro-Life" presidential candidate, even in the face of his multiple pro-abortion votes, in terms of Supreme Court nominees, voting funds to punish people picketing in front of clinics, funds for experimentation upon the bodies of poor aborted babies, etc. Such unconscionable pragmatism is what distinguishes National Right to Life on the one hand from such organizations as Nellie Gray's March for Life, Judi Brown's American Life League, Fr. Paul Marx's Human Life International, Northern Kentucky Right to Life Committee and other principled organizations which do not compromise! When are these Tories going to learn that wages of compromise is defeat!

“PRO-LIFE” - WHAT DOES IT MEAN? WHO IS AND WHO ISN'T?

For many years since the jettisoning by some avant garde people in the anti-abortion movement of the phrase “anti-abortion”, there has been adopted now the phrase “Pro-Life” — over the objection of many who foresaw that it was a phrase that would be badly abused. Well, it has! Everyone claims that they are “Pro-Life”. It has the flaw of all “sound-bite mentality”, that we see all too often in political campaigns. It masks over the more serious underlying questions of what the person does — in specifics!

In this Newsletter, there are many graphic examples of what we are saying here. **When your friend, pastor, relative, political office holder, etc., claims that he/she is “Pro-Life” you need to ask them - specifically:**

- Do you attend the monthly Helpers Prayer Vigil in Cincinnati?
- Have you converted your long distance telephone system from the pro-abort/pro-obscenity/pro-homosexual AT&T, MCI, Sprint to Lifeline?
- Do you belong to any Pro-Life organization (\$10.00 a year for NKRTL subscription???)
- Do you vote for those politicians who effectively keep in place the killing machine, regardless of what they say?
- When is the last Pro-Life event you attended, monthly prayer liturgy, rallies in Washington, Cincinnati, Frankfort, Annual NKRTL Celebration of Life, etc.?
- When is the last time you wrote a letter to your national or state representative, your pastor, your TV or radio station, asserting the absolute requirement of defense of innocent human life?
- Do you respond when someone makes a pro-abortion (or “pro-choice”) assertion in your presence - even if it is your co-worker, boss, relative, pastor, friend ...?

Nutritionists say that we are what we eat. Psychiatrists say that we are what we think. True “Pro-Lifers” say that we are what we do! We need to help all whom we can influence to come to grips with the simple reality that those who do nothing about this holocaust — and indeed effectively support it by voting wrong, supporting the wrong companies, etc. — are not “Pro-Life” and are indeed affirmatively contributing to the holocaust, for which they will be accountable to the Ultimate Judge!
