MORALS AND POLITICS — THE PRESIDENTIAL RACE

There are four strongly Pro-Life Presidential candidates currently in the field:

Gary Bauer

Gary Bauer (R), a local boy from Newport, Ky., was a former member of

the Ronald Reagan Cabinet in Washington, and most recently **President of Family Research Council** of Washington, DC.

This long-time, dedicated and uncompromising Pro-lifer was a speaker at an earlier Celebration of Life of NKRTL.

Bauer has been the second largest money raiser (after **George W. Bush**) and has wide and deep contacts across this nation, especially in the Pro-Life Movement, and the Pro-Family Movement by reason of his connection with **Dr. James Dobson**. In spite of these accomplishments many of the "mainliners" are attempting to write him off.

Recently, **Christian Coalition** founder **Rev. Pat Robertson** called Bauer "a lost cause," and indicated his support for Bush. But we must remember that this is the same Robertson, and the same Christian Coalition, who submarined Buchanan's campaign 4 years ago in South Carolina just after Pat had put together a string of primary victories. Then, Robertson told us how Pro-Life was **Bob "Viagra" Dole** (who now is doing commercials for the impotency drug, and its service to men "and their partners!") He spends the rest of his time (now that his wife Libby has dropped out of the Presidential race), when he isn't out campaigning for stridently

pro-abortion candidates like **New Jersey Gov. Christy Whitman**, hanging out at a prestigious, political Washington, D.C. law firm that includes other pro-abortion ex-senators such as **George Mitchell (D)**, himself a former majority leader in the Senate (when the Democrats were in the majority, just before Dole's ascendancy).

On an Oct. 3, 1999, interview on ABC's "*This Week*," Rev. Robertson described as "an extreme position" on the right to life, one in which "...there was no exception for anything. I mean, there is no exception for rape or incest or the life of the mother or anything. I mean, it was an absolute ban, a criminalization of abortion."

The Pro-Life Movement must discontinue taking its lead from wolves in sheep's clothing.

Impressive testimony to Bauer's strong character came recently from **William Kristol**, who is certainly not supporting Bauer's candidacy and disagrees with him on many issues. Kristol saw him function first-hand in Washington, D.C., and affirmed that Bauer's political courage in precarious situations is his most characteristic trait: "Courage in Washington is a difficult thing ... it's tough to sit in a meeting and say 'no' to people more powerful than yourself."

Pat Buchanan

Pat Buchanan, nationally known columnist and political activist, is another long-time, dedicated and uncompromising Pro-Lifer. Buchanan has announced that while he is "in this race to win, I must leave the Party that has long been my home — because the Washington elite of the GOP has left me and the principles for which I have toiled and fought for 40 years." Buchanan has announced his intention of seeking the Presidential nomination of the **Reform Party**, and of course is being subjected to the kind of criticism from self interested people that Pro-Lifers have come to expect.

Pro-aborts in that Party, such as **Donald** (wife of the month) **Trump**, and **Jesse "The Body" Ventura**, who themselves are interested in that Party's nomination for the Presidency, have smeared Buchanan as anti-Semitic, and "a Hitler-lover," based on a recent book of Buchanan's. Buchanan clearly called both Hitler and Stalin "monsters," who established their Gestapo and NKVD, and death camps. Trump's (im)moral positions have been widely-known to most Americans for years.

Ventura, an ex-wrestler and now governor of Minnesota, is a more recent arrival on the political scene. His moral mentality is graphically seen in a recent interview he gave in *Playboy* magazine wherein he proposed legalization of drugs

Buchanan was interviewed by **NBC News "Meet the Press"** on Sunday, 9/12/99, and was asked "Mr. Buchanan, if the Reform Party is to accept you as their nominee, do they have to accept that you will campaign strongly and publicly on your long-held anti-abortion views?" His answer was "David, if I go into the Reform Party, I will carry with me my convictions, my beliefs, my ideals. One of those is that all human life, innocent human life, is sacred and cannot be taken. If I campaign for the nomination of the Reform Party, I will campaign as a Pro-Life candidate. If I do run for it and they nominate me, the Reform Party candidate will be the most trustworthy candidate on life in the entire race."

He went on to affirm that as President of the United States he will only appoint "constitutionalists and conservatives who

and prostitution and characterized the Navy's Tailhook sexual-assault scandal as "much ado about nothing," and asserted that "organized religion is a sham and a crutch for weak-minded people."

Notice that he is called Jesse "The Body," not Jesse "The Mind." (Dr. Laura observed that he must have shaved his head too close!)

Reform Party Chairman Russell Verney demanded that Ventura resign from the Party, saying that he has "brought shame" to himself with this interview.

Attacks from Buchanan's former colleagues in the Republican Party, who call themselves conservative and call themselves Pro-Life, took the predictable form, as typified by columnist **Mona Charen**, who argues that Buchanan will simply take votes from George W. Bush and "could elect Al Gore or Bill Bradley." She accuses Buchanan of sacrificing "principle" to "egotism" and asks "how much does he care about abortion and other social issues if he is willing to increase the odds that a Democrat will be appointing judges for the next four years?"

The multiple fallacies in this flawed and tired argument are pointed out by the lucid analysis of the incomparable **Joe Sobran** who points out first that her argument is based on the assumption that Buchanan will lose — far from a given!

Sobran then identifies the hypocrisy in this Republican argument, noting the shameful (unstated) conclusion of the Charen argument: "If a Democrat is elected President, he will nominate pro-abortion justices and judges to the Federal courts. But they would still have to be confirmed — and Charen implies that the Republicans would confirm them! And why not? She's quite right, though she doesn't seem to grasp what she is admitting. The allegedly pro-life Republicans have voted overwhelmingly to confirm **Bill Clinton's** pro-abortion nominees, including **Supreme Court Justices Ruth Bader Ginsburg and Stephen Breyer**. Ginsburg was confirmed by a Senate vote of 97-3 and all the Republicans — led by **Orin Hatch of Utah** — absolutely fawned on her ... meanwhile such pro-abortion Justices as **Sandra O'Connor** and **David Souter** were appointed by Republican Presidents — and Republicans in the Senate voted to confirm them. This is exactly why so many conservatives are ready to bolt the Republican Party, and why Buchanan charges that Washington has a one party system 'masquerading' as a two party system."

Alan Keyes

Dr. Alan Keyes (R) was former Ambassador to the United Nations under Pres. Ronald Reagan, and again long-time, dedicated and uncompromising Pro-Lifer.

Howard Phillips

Howard Phillips (and his running mate Joe Sobran) are the nominees of the U.S. Constitution Party (previously known as the Taxpayers' Party). Both of these people are again long-time, dedicated and uncompromising Pro-Lifers, and both also have been past speakers at an NKRTL Celebration of Life.

Phillips is a long-time nationally-known organizer of Pro-Life, pro-family organizations, including **The Conservative Caucus**, and has served at the cabinet level under Pres. Nixon, and resigned when Nixon broke his promise not to abolish the Office of Economic Opportunity. Sobran is of course a long-time and well-known national columnist of great skill and perception, called by many the modern G.K. Chesterton.

Other Candidates

Steve Forbes

Publisher **Steve Forbes** who ran for the Presidency four years ago with a “personally opposed” position on abortion, has moderated his position substantially and claims to be Pro-Life. While many Pro-Lifers are appropriately cautious, and adopting an attitude that they want to see more proof, in fairness it must be pointed out that Mr. Forbes has over the past two years, out of his substantial personal wealth, privately funded the national effort for advertisements demonstrating the horror of partial birth abortion.

He also took a very public role at the National Republican Party level last year, insisting (unsuccessfully) on a resolution by the Party that they would not financially support candidates who were in favor of partial birth abortion.

George W. Bush

George W. Bush, governor of Texas, who continues to be described by the secular media as a shoo-in for the Republican nomination. Calling himself Pro-Life, Bush has become the darling of **National Right to Life Committee**, whose front page newspaper headline of October 12, 1999 read: “Pro-abortion NARAL attacks Pro-Life Gov. George W. Bush.” NRLC ignores the fact that Bush admits that he would not restrict himself to judicial appointments of Pro-Life candidates — which of course his father didn’t do either, and which is precisely why we continue to be in a nation governed by pro-abortion laws! We can’t stand many more “victories” like that!

It must be remembered that four years ago National Right to Life Committee also told us the lie that Bob Dole was “Pro-Life,” and it was then later discovered that NRLC had just received a \$650,000.00 grant from the Republican National Committee!

According to a May 1999 article in “*Texas Lawyer*,” the governor “doesn’t question would-be appointees to the state bench about abortion or school prayer, affirmative action or guns.”

John McCain

Another Pro-Life pretender is **U.S. Sen. John McCain (R)**.

As a guest of NBC “*Meet the Press*” on 9/12/99, McCain said: “I’d love to see a point where Roe v. Wade is irrelevant and could be repealed because abortion is no longer necessary. But certainly in the short-term, or even the long-term, I would not support the repeal of Roe v. Wade, which would then force X number of women in America to undergo illegal and dangerous operations.”

Against the obvious unambiguity of that pro-abortion statement, McCain back-pedaled with a gobblety-gook explanation: “I would support the movement in that direction, and I believe that this goal that we all seek — what I’m trying

to say here is that we need a dialogue in America and in our party between pro-life and pro-choice people, maintaining our pro-life position as a Party so we can achieve the goal that both pro-choice and pro-life people seek.

“That’s what I’m trying to do,” continued McCain. “There are many areas we can work together — adoption, foster care, education. There are so many things that we can work together and help rearrange the parameters of this debate so, perhaps, we can get out of the gridlock that we’re in. And that’s what I was trying to say. I said it inartfully and I will say many other things inartfully, but ...”

No, Sen. McCain, you said it rather clearly the first time, that you “would not support the repeal of Roe v. Wade, which would then force X number of women in America to undergo illegal and dangerous operations.” It has nothing to do with dialogue or with other related problems, but simply whether or not you would support the reversal of the decision that authorizes the killing annually of 1.5 million innocent unborn babies! “No amount of perfume will take the blood from these hands ... “ (Shakespeare, *MacBeth*)

National Right to Life Committee had no difficulty in seeing that McCain is not Pro-Life. One wonders why they have this blindness with respect to George W. Bush?

McCain’s other backers include former **U.S. Sen. Warren Rudman (R) of NH**, who was a 100% pro-aborter in the Congress, and **Sen. Mike DeWine (R) of Ohio**, who calls himself Pro-Life, although he admits to being in favor of killing the innocent for the crime of the guilty (abortion for rape and incest).

Gore and Bradley

Vice Pres. Al Gore (D), and his challenger, former U.S. Sen. Bill Bradley faithfully uphold the Democrat position, genuflecting to abortion on demand and the public financing thereof.

Gore's wife, Tipper, who several years ago timidly tested the moral conservative waters by some criticism of the hard rock music industry (and has publicly repented of that sin by appearing recently with a heavy metal group), was the keynote speaker last Dec. at Planned Parenthood Federation of America, and supported the woman's "right" to abortion, criticizing Pro-Life opposition which she says "has been reduced to murder and maiming."

The latest incredible debachery by Gore is hiring, as one of his highest paid consultants in his campaign, according to a story in the *Washington Post*, feminist Naomi Wolf. In her most recent book "*Promiscuities*," Ms. Wolf argued that schools should teach such things as masturbation, because it is more realistic than abstinence and safer than sexual intercourse! She also maintains that the best way to strike a balance between abstinence and sexual intercourse is to teach oral sex which is "as sensible as teaching kids to drive!"

Party above Principle

We must be clear that we are not criticizing Pro-Life politicians who truly support the Pro-Life cause, some of whom are Republicans, some of whom are Democrats. We have been blessed to have some sincerely dedicated Pro-Lifers remaining in each of those Parties, but we must not delude ourselves, nor should we let any politicians delude themselves, by falling into the trap of placing Party above Principle.

The Bible reminds us "Put not your trust in princes, in man whom there is no salvation." (Trust in God alone) Psalms 145:3

People who support the Bushes, or the Gores, or the Bradleys, or the McCains, when there are committed people of principle as alternatives, are simply compromising their basic principles, which is always immoral, and has inevitably led to failure.

We need to be reminded of the same situation that occurred in 1850 when the then dominant Whig Party refused to address the immorality of slavery; and principled people left that party and formed another party.

The new party's first candidate for president lost. Four years later, Abraham Lincoln was the candidate of that party, the Republican Party, and won, and the Whig Party was consigned to the ash bin of history. And so, the Republican Party was born out of moral principle — the rejection of the slavery of our black brothers and sisters.

The Democratic Party is officially on record in its Platform as supporting the present legal status of the mother's right to kill her unborn child, and indeed to finance such abomination with your tax money. The Republican Party, while giving lip service to the contrary in its Platform, has effectively, through its leadership, abandoned the Pro-Life cause and refused to implement the Pro-Life plank in its Platform, including the appointment of Pro-Life judges.

These are difficult times in which there is occurring a realignment of political interests in this nation, along moral lines — we cannot abandon principle!!!

A PRO-LIFE SYLLOGISM

Pro-Life advocates have one primary argument against abortion that abortion advocates do not, and cannot, squarely address:

- Premise 1: Abortion is the killing of an innocent, living human being.
- Premise 2: Killing innocent, living human beings is wrong.
- Conclusion: Abortion is wrong.

The obviously logical and unassailable conclusion reached above is paralleled by an equally compelling logical syllogism:

- Premise 1: Pro-abortion judges and legislators initiated and perpetuate the legalized killing of unborn children.
- Premise 2: Pro-abortion judges and legislators are appointed and supported by pro-abortion politicians.
- Conclusion: Those who support and elect these pro-abortion politicians, who perpetuate the legalized killing of unborn children, contribute directly to the continued killing of unborn children.

Religious Support

This clear moral principle has been supported by many in organized religion, including the late Cardinal Archbishop Humberto Medeiros of Boston: "Those who make abortions possible by law — such as legislators and those who promote, defend and elect these same lawmakers — cannot separate themselves totally from that guilt which accompanies this horrendous crime and deadly sin."

Political Weaseling

It is amazing, in this 20th century so captivated with communication and media information, that so many politicians have been able, so successfully, to continue to play the "Emperor's clothes" game. Their effort to avoid "political accountability" for their actions is not only irresponsible, but indeed juvenile. We have a right to expect our elected officials not only to vote and act in principled ways within their own office, but to refuse to prostitute themselves by supporting for elective office those who support and perpetuate the greatest holocaust and human slaughter in recorded history.

Until we stop playing the "Emperor's clothes" game, the killing will continue.

POPULATION PROPAGANDA

"More doom and gloom is predicted by Holger Jensen, Foreign Editor with the Denver Rocky Mountain News in his editorial "World's Population Growth Means Trouble for the Environment.

"Without citing any scientific, economic or business sources, this columnist relies solely on the predictions of the UN that there will be 'full scale emergencies' resulting from an increase in population.

"For over twenty-five years the news media has saturated us with dire predictions of environmental crisis and shortage of food and natural resources. 'Global Warming,' 'Chemical Poisoning,' 'Resource Depletion,' 'Depletion of Ozone,' and 'Global Famine,' are terms freely used as though they were established facts.

"While Carter was President, he predicted that by 1990 we would run out of oil.

"In his book *Population Bomb*, biologist **Paul Ehrlich** predicted, 'in the 1970's hundreds of millions of people are going to starve to death.'

"With the assistance of the news media, population controllers have convinced many that the root cause of poverty, hunger, disease, and conflict is 'overpopulation.' The solution to our social problems then becomes simple: reduce the number of people.

"But, is a crisis pending?"

FACTS

"The world isn't running out of food or farming resources. The globe could feed another two billion people right now, mainly on the good land diverted from crops by government policies in the U.S. and Argentina.' *Wall Street Journal*

"**Julian Simon, Professor of Business Administration at University of Maryland**, states: 'Today there is a solid scientific proof that population growth does not hinder economic development, and does not cause resource depletion.'

"What is the most densely populated area in the world? Hong Kong. One of the most densely populated nations is Japan. Both are places of affluence.

"In March, 1990, the U.S. Dept. Of Agriculture released a 70 year study indicating that rural temperatures had actually grown colder, not warmer, in contradiction to the 'greenhouse effect' theory.

"*The Reader's Digest* article 'Is the World Really Coming to an End?' debunks the media-created myths that man-made chemicals are causing cancer epidemics, that men are

becoming sterile because of pollution, that the world's forests are shrinking, and that the alleged disappearing ozone layer is causing skin cancer. The article goes on to document from scientific sources that the fear of 'global warming' has no basis.

GOVERNMENT CONTROL

"The reason why environmental extremists, governments, and the news media create this 'crisis' is so that they can offer a solution of more governmental control.

"**Timothy Wirth**, Clinton's Counselor for Global Affairs (a newly-created bureaucracy) stated in 1993: 'Population must be at the top of our agenda for global cooperation — it dwarfs all others in terms of importance and its difficulty ... our position is to support reproductive choice including access to safe abortion.'

"**Sheldon Richman** with CATP Institute in Washington, DC warns: 'What the antinatalist-environmental movement regards as a looming catastrophe is nothing of the kind. The movement's claims are based on bad science, half truths, and flawed economic analysis, and structured to convince the public that disaster is imminent unless people surrender their personal rights to government. Among the freedoms to be sacrificed is the deeply personal decision on the number of children they will have.'

"There is now an enormous array of UN agencies and related affiliates claiming an official interest in the reproductive decisions of the world's families,' observes Jacqueline R. Kasun, Professor of Economics Emeritus at Humboldt State

University in California. Kasun continues: 'The real cause of poverty and pollution throughout the world is not overpopulation but government mismanagement of economic life, heavy taxes, corruption, restrictions on trade and productive effort, and misuse of resources.'

"The *Time* article 'Overpopulation, Too Many Mouths to Feed' stated: 'Religion presents perhaps the greatest obstacle to population control,' directing its criticism especially at the Catholic Church which morally condemns contraception, sterilization and abortion.

"Hopefully *Time* is correct and Churches will be an obstacle to the plans of those environmental extremists whose real goal is the destruction of people, especially unborn children.

“People of faith, on the other hand, have long realized that the greatest resource any nation has is its people, for man is the greatest resource the world has ever known. It is man’s ability to reason which allows him to use the earth’s resources for his betterment, and which, when combined with a faith in God and a reverence for all people, causes nations to prosper, raising up and not diminishing their neighbors.

“People are viewed by the doom and gloom population control crowd as simply ‘more mouths to feed.’ However, God creates people so that there will be heads to think, hearts to love, and hands to work.”

THERE ARE NONE SO BLIND AS THOSE WHO WILL NOT SEE

The September 17, *Kentucky Post* column of Jack Hicks criticized **NKRTL** and its Pres., **Robert C. Cetrulo**, for not “blasting Bunning” for the Senator’s endorsement of **Republican Peppy Martin** for Governor. Hicks correctly points out that NKRTL was critical of former **State Rep. Bill Donnermeyer** for supporting the pro-abortion gubernatorial candidate Paul Patton in 1995.

First, there should be noted the facts of Cetrulo’s public response in a news story of September 15 captioned “Martin endorsement upsets Cetrulo”: “I’m not too happy with what Jim Bunning did. ...both [Patton and Martin] are unacceptable. We wouldn’t dirty our hands with an endorsement.”

NKRTL’s decisions are always based on moral principle. The moral principle involved in this instance is that it is wrong to put in office a person who will perpetuate the immorality of the killing of unborn children.

But as explained in the pastoral of the **Most Rev. John Meyers, Bishop of Peoria, IL**: “Abortion and the Obligation of Catholics” (June 1990): “There are also certain limited circumstances (as in an election between two pro-abortion candidates, one of whom is more extreme than the other) in which it is possible for a Catholic legitimately to vote for a pro-abortion candidate ... **A Catholic may support the candidacy of someone who would permit unjust killing only when the real alternatives are candidates who would permit even more unjust killing.**”

Martin, who does not oppose the legalization of abortion, at least stated that she would not veto any Pro-Life legislation, if elected as governor. On the contrary, Mr. Patton in his earlier campaign committed himself to veto such legislation, and did in fact do so after his election!

Let’s compare the consequences of Donnermeyer’s 1995 endorsement of a pro-abortion Democrat Patton, and Bunning’s 1999 endorsement of a pro-abortion Republican Martin. If Martin were to defeat Patton, what would be the consequences to the Pro-Life Movement? Is it harmed? The position of the Pro-Life Movement would not worsened by a defeat of Patton by Martin, and in fact may be enhanced in that she has committed herself not to veto Pro-Life legislation.

The **Republican Party** was born out of a moral principle — the rejection of the slavery of our black brothers and sisters. In 1850, the then-dominant **Whig Party** refused to take an anti-slavery stance. In 1856, the fledgling Republican Party elected its first President, **Abraham Lincoln**, and the Whig

On the other hand, when Patton defeated Republican Larry Forgy in 1995, with the overt help of Donnermeyer, the results were directly and seriously damaging to the Pro-Life cause. Patton and his wife spoke against the Pro-Life legislation, lobbied against it, and he then vetoed one of the pieces after passage which, fortunately we were able to pass over his veto.

Next, the pro-abortion people that Patton appointed in the Dept. of Human Services to recommend the regulations for the Pro-Life Clinic Health Bill (which placed restrictions on abortion clinics) guaranteed that the intention of the General Assembly would be neutered. In fact, the appointees included representatives of Planned Parenthood, and people who operated abortion clinics.

Actions do have consequences! Endorsing pro-abort candidates over Pro-Life opponents supports the continuation of destruction of innocent human life. Those who really care about unborn children understand the political priority of this moral issue, and the importance of stopping the killing of 4400 unborn babies each day in the United States.

It is not our purpose to defend Sen. Bunning’s endorsement of Peppy Martin. Indeed, NKRTL-PAC Board decided that neither Patton nor Martin nor Gatewood Galbraith deserved an endorsement.

Sen. Bunning does indeed have a 100% Pro-Life voting record both in the House and in the Senate and does deserve our ongoing support. If he ever does endorse a pro-abort candidate over a Pro-Lifer, you will indeed hear us openly criticize him.

Columnist Hicks demonstrates his anti-antiabortion mentality, extending his argument against us to assert: “Cetrulo and his followers will likely forgive area Republican legislators for their endorsement of Presidential hopeful George W. Bush ... whose pronouncements on abortion so far haven’t been in total agreement with anti-abortion activists.”

The reality is that we wrote to the legislators Hicks names criticizing their having signed a letter encouraging George W. Bush to run for the Presidency. When we pointed out the sorry record of Mr. Bush on the Pro-Life issues, they wrote and withdrew their support, identifying as their reason the fact he is not Pro-Life.

Mr. Hicks’ deceptive effort to paint NKRTL and Cetrulo as apologists for the Republican Party is untruthful, and he knows it. Hicks ignores the record of our endorsement of many Democrats. Hicks ignores our picketing of the pro-abortion Bob Dole campaign, ignores our endorsement during that Presidential race of the U.S. Constitution Party’s candidate Howard Phillips over both Dole and Clinton and ignores our praise of Pat Buchanan who has left the Republican Party to run as a third party candidate.

The Pro-Life Movement takes it’s cue, in terms of its political involvement, from the Bible: “Place not your trust in princes ...” Psalms 145:3. All of us human beings are capable of falling short of the mark. We have never placed total confidence in any politician, nor indeed in any political party.

Party was consigned to the dust bin of history. The Republican Party may well be on the same road to obscurity as it compromises and weasels on the most fundamental moral/political issue of this century — the sanctity of all innocent human life.

Hicks should give more serious study to the guiding principle asserted by the *Kentucky Post* on its masthead: "Give the people the light, and they will find their way." A reading of his distortion of the record on these issues demonstrates that his purpose is not to clarify, but rather to obscure.

The pro-abortion, feminoid columnist, **Ellen Goodman**, recently wrote favorably about the incredibly frightening paper published by a Stanford Law Professor and a University of Chicago economist, **attributing the alleged drop in crime rate to permissive abortion**, legalized in 1973 by *Roe v. Wade*. She concedes, but blithely passes over, "myriad other things that influence crime rates, from prison sentencing to policing to jobs."

What Goes Around Comes Around — Eugenics Again

She gives brief mention to (but obviously doesn't understand) the dangerous eugenic movement that seized the United States in the '20's and '30's, resulting in the passage of laws in 31 states to forcibly sterilize the "handicapped" — until the Nazi experience painfully brought to the rest of the world the realization of the fatal flaw in that mentality.

Ms. Goodman, who recognizes this alleged statistical link between abortion and crime as a "leap" in logic nonetheless concludes that it has a "whiff of common sense," and bases her position in the argument that the question is "about unwantedness."

Why Stop There?

The author concludes, in defense of her main theme of "wantedness": "It's what family planners have said all along. It's not really such a puzzle."

If she is correct, then of course the question is "Why stop there?" Knowing the extremely high rate of criminal recidivism, why not "abort" all prison inmates, insuring thereby of course the avoidance of their future crimes, and also their non-reproduction (and simultaneously reducing that extravagant cost to the rest of us "perfect beings.")?

And if we can determine that an unborn child has a good chance of becoming a criminal, presumably we could do the same for a 5-year old, whom we could then eliminate, as well

as sterilize all women who have a high risk of bearing such children.

And we could also identify adults who are more likely, on the basis of some characteristic, to be criminals, and take precautionary action. But wait, we have already done that: it's called racial profiling, and **Vice President Gore** just described that as a hate crime!

Ms. Goodman fails to mention of course the inconvenient writings of **Margaret Sanger**, founder of **Planned Parenthood**, who, in the 1930's, was writing the same kind of pre-Nazi nonsense: "more children from the fit, less from the unfit."

And she of course fails to mention the natural consequences of that mentality which led us to such incredible realities, which we now choose to forget, such as the Nazi experimentation upon "sub-humans" by the Angel of Death at Dachau, **Dr. Albert Mengele**.

In the Foreword to "The Rise and Fall of the Third Reich" by the philosopher **Satayana**, he reminded us of the painful truism "Those who do not remember the past, are condemned to relive it."

QUOTES FROM "LIFEWATCH," PUBLISHED BY THE TASKFORCE OF UNITED METHODISTS ON ABORTION AND SEXUALITY

The Newsletter of TUMAS states its mission: "Out of obedience to **Jesus Christ**, we will work to create in church and society esteem for human life at its most vulnerable, specifically for the unborn child and the woman who contemplates abortion."

In its March 1, 1999 Newsletter, this organization has a very interesting article: "The Church's Historic Teaching on Abortion: A Sketch."

"Here we are. Ecclesial sons and daughters of **John Wesley** ... And confronting a culture of death, including the sin of abortion.

"We are not the first Christians to confront abortion. Far from it. From the first years of the primitive, apostolic community, the Church has had teaching — solid teaching, substantive teaching, unambiguous teaching — on abortion. In our time — which lacks memory of what happened eighteen days ago let alone what happened eighteen centuries, decades, years, months, or weeks ago — the historic teaching of the Church in any area is all too easily forgotten. Thanks be to God that our forgetfulness does not thereby eliminate the truthful teaching of those who have gone before us. ...

"In the primitive churches of the first century, an instructional document on Christian morals and congregational discipline, entitled *The Didache*, circulated. It had this to say about life and abortion: 'There are two ways; the one is that of life and the other is that of death. There is a great difference between the two ways. The Way of Life is this: first, you shall love the God Who made you; second, you shall love your neighbor as yourself. Everything that you do not wish to be done to you, do not do to another! ...

“You shall not kill. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not corrupt children. You shall not practice sexual promiscuity. You shall not steal. You shall not practice magic. You shall not mix poisons, not secure an abortion or kill the unborn child...”

“The Way of Death is the way of those ... who kill their children by abortion and destroy God’s creatures, who turn their backs on the poor and oppress the afflicted ... Save yourselves, children, from all these!” ...

“**Tertullian**, an African Church Father, wrote around 223 A.D.: ‘The life in the womb may not be destroyed.’

“In the fourth century, **St. Basil the Great**, one of the Cappadocian Fathers, declared: ‘The woman who purposely destroys her unborn child is guilty of murder. The hair-splitting difference between formed and unformed makes no difference to us. In this case, it is not only the being about to be born who is victimized, but the woman in her attack upon herself...’

“[Abortion] is one of only several moral issues on which not one dissenting opinion has ever been expressed by the Church Fathers.” ...

“The early Church’s consensus on abortion held throughout the Middle Ages. It also held firm during the Reformation period. For example, **Martin Luther** asserted: ‘For those who have no regard for pregnant women and who do not spare the tender fruit are murderers and infanticides.’ ...

“**John Calvin** followed the tradition on life and abortion that he had received: ‘If it seems more horrible to kill a man in his own house than in a field, because a man’s house is his most secure place of refuge, it ought surely to be deemed more atrocious to destroy the unborn in the womb before it has come to light.’ ...

“As a part of the English Reformation and as the father of Methodism, **John Wesley** continued the Church’s teaching on abortion. **Robert B. Mussman** has described Wesley’s position: ‘The killing of infants Wesley called ‘the basest of murders.’ In his powerful indictment of the depravity of the Indians in Georgia, ‘except perhaps the Choctaws,’ he called them ‘murderers of their own children — it being a common thing ... for a woman either to procure abortion, or to throw her child into the next river, because she will go with her husband to the war.’ He related that a woman deserted by her man often would kill the children she had borne him. ...”

“For [John Wesley] abortion was the murder of unborn children.’

“**Karl Barth**, the great systematic theologian of the twentieth century, carried on the Church’s understanding of life and abortion: ‘The unborn child is from the very first a child.

It is still developing and has no independent life. But it is a man and not a thing, not a mere part of the mother’s body ... He who destroys germinating life kills a man ... The fact that a definite No must be the presupposition of further discussion cannot be contested, least of all today.’

“Writing in a culture that devalued life, **Dietrich Bonhoeffer**, the great German theologian asserted: ‘Destruction of the embryo in the mother’s womb is a violation of the right to live which God has bestowed upon this nascent

A group of us met and formed a local **Helpers of God’s Precious Infants** chapter, consisting primarily of the regular prayer pickets at the abortion clinic for many years, plus a cadre of **Northern Kentucky Right to Life** members, and

life. To raise the question whether we are here concerned already with a human being or not is merely to confuse the issue. The simple fact is that God certainly intended to create a human being and that this nascent human being has been deliberately deprived of his life. And that is nothing but murder.

A great many different motives may lead to an action of this kind. ... All these considerations must no doubt have a quite decisive influence on our personal and pastoral attitude towards the person concerned, but they cannot in any way alter the fact of murder.’

“United Methodist **Paul Ramsey**, who taught and wrote Christian ethics at Princeton University, demonstrated his disagreement with abortion on demand, and engaged the ecclesial and secular powers that be, with these words: ‘the [U.S. Supreme Court] opened the door to weighing human lives according to comparative worthiness, or something called ‘meaningfulness. ... Ineluctably we pass from abortion to infanticide, whether the justices know it or not. Ineluctably, because many of the reasons alleged to justify permissive abortion have equal force in justifying the killing of neonates in hospital nurseries.’ ...

“But one thing is clear: over the centuries, the Church has had straightforward, consistent teaching on life and abortion. And it is time that The United Methodist Church receive and teach this part of the Great Tradition of the Church. This is our hope. This is our prayer. This is our witness. ...

“It is time for United Methodism to forsake the middle and take the side of life.”

TO RUSSIA WITH L♥VE

George Riess, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of **Women’s Support Center of Kettering, Ohio**, a Dayton suburb, was in town recently to speak at **Old St. Mary’s Church**, Over the Rhine in Cincinnati, to promote support for a courageous outreach which his organization is making to establish a Pro-Life presence in Russia.

Mr. Riess explained that the initiative was pioneered by a young priest who suddenly showed up in Dayton a few years ago, **Fr. Jim Kelleher**. This of course is a name well-known to people of this area, since Fr. Kelleher showed up in Cincinnati about the same time, praying with a bunch of us on our regular Saturday 10:00 a.m. Rosary at the abortion clinic on Auburn Avenue in Cincinnati. He then explained to us a project which had been started in Brooklyn, NY, by **Msgr. Philip Reilly, Helpers of God’s Precious Infants**, which involved the saying of a Mass one Saturday a month, followed by a Rosary procession to the abortion clinic.

brought Msgr. Reilly in to Cincinnati. The project has now successfully gone on for 3-1/2 years, on the **second Saturday of each month, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.** with 8:00 a.m. Mass at the Holy Name Church, Auburn and Taft, followed by

a Rosary procession to the abortuary and then Benediction back at the Church, concluding at 10:00 a.m. We continue to attract several hundred people each month in **this most important effort of the Pro-Life Movement — prayer**, thanks to Fr. Kelleher.

This modern day St. Paul has now seeded another important viable Pro-Life program, establishing a Women's Support Center in Vladivostok, on the far eastern edge of Russia on the Sea of Japan, a seaport city of one million people, and is the first problem pregnancy support center in eastern Russia. They have met with quite a bit of success, in a culture where, tragically, the average Russian woman has had between four and eight abortions in her life, where abortions are free, and where costs to deliver a child strains the poverty level budget of the average Russian, and where religion has been suppressed for 70 years.

U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CRIMINALIZES "PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE"

The pro-abortion media, and their collaborators in the medical and legal professions, reacted with professionally-feigned indignation at the recent passage by the U.S. House of Representatives (261 to 156) of legislation that would prohibit what is euphemistically called "physician assisted suicide," under which the doctor kills the patient.

Cong. Henry Hyde, presenting the Pro-Life position on the floor of the House, posed the question as to whether we "wish to add execution to the list of services provided by physicians."

Rep. David Weldon (R) of FL, explained his vote in favor of this Bill, pointing out that, as a physician, he has never seen a case where a competent physician has been unable to appropriately alleviate the pain of a patient: "It is a bankrupt and lazy way out" for the doctor. Dr. Weldon went on to say that it is "actually getting easier to manage pain today with the medication." He condemned the Oregon law permitting physician assisted suicide as unethical and contrary to appropriate medical ethics. Dr. Weldon pointed out that the **American Medical Association** supports this Bill, which specifically exempts from prosecution physicians who administer pain killing medication to their patients, without the intent to kill.

The matter moves to the Senate, and readers are requested to write Sens. Bunning and McConnell asking their support for this Bill (HR-2260).

Sens. Bunning and McConnell have both been requested on several occasions to co-sponsor this legislation in the U.S. Senate, S.1272, and they have declined to do so. Readers will no doubt be interested in writing to them and inquiring why they have declined to co-sponsor such important and effective Pro-Life legislation.

"Killing" ... Is "Killing"!

Mother Teresa "assisted" many people "in dying" and "helped" many people "to die." She was present to them, assuring them that they would not die alone. Joan Appleton, the founder of the U.S. Chapter of **Society of Centurions** states: “We are people who have dropped our swords against the unborn. ...It is very, very difficult to reach an acceptance of what you have done. But God is very good. He doesn’t give us the full realization of the horror that we’ve done immediately. I left the abortion business in 1989 after running a clinic for five years. CONGRESSIONAL PRO-LIFE SCORE-CARD: DEMS CONSISTENTLY PRO-ABORT; REPUBS LESS CONSISTENTLY PRO-LIFE

“Campaign Reform” Bill

A significant Pro-Life victory was just achieved in the U.S. Senate, which defeated the Shays-Meehan Bill, which would have placed significant restrictions upon expenditures in connection with publicizing candidates’ stands on issues. While this legislation masqueraded under the false facade of “campaign reform,” the reality was that it would have penalized small players such as Northern Kentucky Right to Life, in terms of what they could publish in their newsletters concerning candidates stands on issues, and certain political advertising and broadcast commercials within 60 days of an election.

Attempt to Restrict Political Speech Constitutional Rights of Pro-Lifers

The legislation was patently unconstitutional, violating a 1976 decision of the U.S. Supreme Court, *Buckley v. Valeo*, which upheld such publications as a matter of free speech, against such attempted restrictions.

power of the State Election Registry of Finance, which ultimately resulted in our total acquittal based upon the Constitutional doctrines involved.

Congressman Lucas Votes Pro-Abort

The Bill had passed the U.S. House of Representatives, before being defeated in the Senate. Regrettably, Northern Kentucky's member to the U.S. House of Representatives, **Repr. Ken Lucas (D)** voted in favor of this pro-abortion piece of legislation.

This was particularly disappointing since Mr. Lucas had voted in favor of several other Pro-Life measures since becoming a member of Congress, after having a particularly strong pro-abortion record prior to entering Congress — supporting pro-abortion candidates, refusing to be involved in any Pro-Life activity, appointing pro-abortion members to the Northern Kentucky Health District which approved the use of taxpayers funds for the so-called “morning after” pill which causes abortion, and refusing our specific request to exercise his vote on that Board to support a Pro-Life position.

U.S. Senators from Ky. **Jim Bunning** and **Mitch McConnell**, both cast Pro-Life votes.

Partial Birth Abortion Ban

This legislation, which would prohibit the late-term abortion procedure known as partial birth abortion (under which the abortionist inverts the child and delivers it feet first, and then, while the head is still in the womb, punctures the neck and sucks out the brains, delivering a dead baby) has passed twice before and been vetoed by our pro-abortion **President, Bill Clinton (D)**.

This Bill was repassed by the Senate, 63-34, but is several votes short of a veto-proof situation. Senators Bunning and McConnell cast Pro-Life votes.

The Unborn Victims of Violence Act

The U.S. House of Representatives passed, on Sept. 30, 1999, a Bill which holds criminals responsible if they commit an already defined federal act of violence against a pregnant woman that results in harm or death to her unborn child. This legislation of course is vehemently opposed by the pro-aborts because it recognizes the unborn child as a member of the human family.

Sens. Bunning and McConnell have both been written, on several occasions, asking them to co-sponsor this legislation in the U.S. Senate. They have declined to do so. Readers should inquire of these Senators why they are hesitant to co-sponsor such Pro-Life legislation.

The Right to Life Act of 1999

HR-639 seeks to implement equal protection under the 14th Article of Amendment to the U.S. Constitution for the right to life of each born and preborn human person, from the moment of fertilization.

There is a counterpart Bill in the Senate, but neither has been moved out of Committee. These are perhaps the most important Pro-Life measures pending in the Congress.

Again, Sens. Bunning and McConnell have been written and asked to co-sponsor the Senate version of this piece of legislation, and have declined. Again, readers will no doubt be interested in inquiring of these Sens. why they are hesitant to co-sponsor such important and effective Pro-Life legislation.

Senate Passes Resolution Supporting the Continuation of Roe v. Wade

By a vote of 51-47, senators passed a non-binding resolution that affirmed the validity of Roe v. Wade, legalizing abortion, and recommending its continuation. Eight Republicans joined 43 of the Senate's 45 Democrats in support of it. Sens. Bunning and McConnell cast Pro-Life votes.

Unfortunately, again, proof that the Republican Party is not as consistently Pro-Life as the Democratic Party is consistently pro-abortion. The Republican Party's “control” of the Senate obviously fails on many Pro-Life votes.

Senate Dodges Nasty Issue of “Sale of Body Parts” of Aborted Babies

Sen. Bob Smith of NH (I) proposed an amendment that would permit the U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services to track the sale of body parts of aborted babies. Donation only is permitted, and sale is illegal. Nonetheless, his measure failed by a vote of 46 in favor to 51 opposed, even though the Republicans in the Senate number 55, so that of course 9 Republicans cast pro-abortion votes.
