38th TRAGIC ANNIVERSARY OF THE WAR ON THE UNBORN

More than 300,000 youthful, volunteer, resilient, and optimistic Pro-Lifers descended upon the Capitol in Washington, D.C., on January 24, 2011. While there was the usual media blackout on the television nationwide, the national organizer of March for Life, 85-year-old retired attorney **Nellie Gray**, who initiated the march in January of 1974, one year after *Roe v. Wade*, stated that the number of marchers this year “far exceeded last year’s figure, which was estimated at well over 300,000.” **The largest grassroots volunteer organization in the history of the nation is alive and healthy and committed to continuation until the sanctity of all innocent human life is again recognized by law, and represents the longest, continuous march on the Capitol in U.S. history!**

The many speakers addressing the large crowd before the march began included the largest delegation of members of Congress ever: “The tide has turned,” stated **U.S. Rep. Eric Cantor (R) of Virginia**, the newly elected House Majority Leader, who pointed out that the November elections produced “the biggest pro-life congressional freshman class in memory.”

More than 40,000 rallied at the **7th Annual Walk for Life West Coast** along a 2.5-mile walk near the Golden Gate Bridge. The principal speaker there was **Abby Johnson**, 30, who quit her job as director of **Texas Planned Parenthood** in 2009 after she assisted at a sonogram abortion, where she for the first time witnessed the unborn child frantically fleeing for its life in the womb from the abortion machine.

Many others participated again in the annual **March for Life newspaper ad** sponsored for more than 35 years now by **Northern Kentucky Right to Life**.

The pro-life protest was solemnized by hundreds of other peaceful, prayerful demonstrations across the nation, including the **27th Annual Pro-Life Rosary Procession along Sixth Street in downtown Cincinnati on Saturday, January 22**, from Cincinnati City Hall to Fountain Square, where a rally was held.

Truth Ultimately Prevails

With the takeover of the U.S. House of Representatives now by a vibrant group of **seriously pro-life** Republicans, there has been introduced a variety of pro-life bills which seem to have a serious prospect for passage, including a bill to de-fund Planned Parenthood, the so-called non-profit corporation which in fact posts millions of dollars of annual profit, kills more babies than any other agency in the United States, and routinely is funded by your tax dollars.

While the "Deathocrat" Party still controls the U.S. Senate, its numbers have been diminished, and it is suspected that the message of the last election will not be lost on those who stand for election two years from now, when we have every reason to hope to retire them as well, and simultaneously retire the most pro-abortion president in the history of the United States, **Barack Obama**.

A Synoptic History of U.S. Abortion

For those too young to have experienced it, and for those getting to be too old to remember it, we thought it would be useful to set forth a synoptic history of the tragedy of legalized abortion in the United States. The first part of this piece is taken from *Lifewatch*, a quarterly newsletter for United Methodists (6/1/10):

"In 1963, Alan Guttmacher admitted that any change in the abortion laws that suggested the nonhumanity of the fetus would 'be voted down by the body politic.' The facts bear him out. In 1967, [so-called] 'reform' measures, usually concerning therapeutic exceptions [to state laws prohibiting abortion], were turned aside in Arizona, Georgia, New York, Indiana, North Dakota, New Mexico, Nebraska, and New Jersey. In 1969, such bills failed to emerge from committee in Iowa and Minnesota, and were defeated outright in Nevada and Illinois. In 1970, exceptions based on therapeutic reasons were defeated in Vermont and Massachusetts.

"In 1973, on the eve of *Roe v. Wade*, repeal bills [that is, bills that would have eliminated state laws against abortion] were voted down in Montana, New Mexico, Iowa, Minnesota, Maryland, Colorado, Massachusetts, Georgia, Connecticut, Illinois, Maine, Ohio, and North Dakota. In 1972, even as *Roe* was under consideration by the Supreme Court, the Massachusetts House by a landslide vote of 178 to 46 passed a measure that would have bestowed the full legal rights of children on fetuses from the moment of conception. At the same time, the supreme courts of South Dakota and Missouri upheld their states'

anti-abortion laws. It was surely telling that during the very month that Justice Blackmun finished the draft of his *Roe* opinion, 61 percent of the voters in Michigan and 77 percent in North Dakota by referendum voted down repeal.

"To be sure, reformers and repealers won a few legislative victories prior to *Roe*. In 1967, Colorado liberalized its law. But it placed restrictions on abortion that were much more severe than anything permitted by post-*Roe* federal courts. Reform legislation also passed in North Carolina (1968), but with the rejection of mental-health exceptions. California (1967), Georgia (1968), and South Carolina (1970) changed, but did not repeal, their abortion laws.

"The two most significant legislative victories for the repealers took place in 1970 in New York and Hawaii. These victories, however, were narrow and contentious and did not approximate the percentages of pro-life victories in other states at the same time. At the time of *Roe*, there was evidence that the tide of opinion in New York had shifted back toward laws protecting the unborn.

"A few weeks before the 1972 referendum in Michigan, the polls showed that 56 percent of the people in Michigan supported the proposal to repeal laws against abortion. However, when the votes were counted, 61 percent voted down the repeal proposal. This was the last statewide test of abortion on demand before the Supreme Court imposed its own solution, and it represented an overwhelming rejection of the idea that individuals are answerable to no one other than themselves in the matter of abortion.

"Earlier in this century Margaret Sanger claimed a right to be 'a free, self-directed, autonomous personality.' But when put to referendum, and, when debated in democratic assemblies, the American people have not approved such a 'right.' Whether it was the contraception debate of the WWI period, the abortion debate prior to *Roe*, or the homosexual and euthanasia debate today, whenever the people have had a chance to exercise their judgment, and whenever the terms of the debate are clear and not hidden behind judicial proceedings, the people have not and still will not buy this 'right.'"

Pro-Life Response to Roe v. Wade

The second part of this article is taken from excerpts from the excellent book by constitutional law professor **Charles E. Rice**, *50 Questions on Abortion, Euthanasia and Related Issues*:

"Shouldn't the primary objective of the pro-life movement be the achievement of unity within the movement? Surprisingly to some, the answer is no.

"There are differences of judgment among opponents of abortion as to what should be the objectives as well as the tactics of the pro-life movement. Unity is desirable, but it cannot be the *primary* objective of any movement founded on essential and unchanging principle.

"It is absolutely wrong to hold that the life of any innocent human being is subject to termination at the pleasure of a legislative majority. This is the point of the

controversy over the states' rights and personhood approaches. And the experience of the past three decades teaches that adherence to principle is the most effective way to restore constitutional protection to the right to life. From 1973 to 1981, the pro-life movement grew and made progress. Although it argued the abortion issue primarily in secular, constitutional terms, it generally adhered to the objective that *Roe v. Wade* must be overturned by the restoration of the principle that all human beings are persons entitled under the Constitution to the right to live. The movement, however, treated abortion itself as the problem rather than as a symptom of deeper ills. And it became increasingly dominated at the national level by those who regarded abortion as a negotiable political issue susceptible of compromise in the same way as a highway appropriation.

"In January 1981, the Human Life Bill was introduced in Congress by Senator Jesse Helms and Representative Henry Hyde. The HLB would have used Congress' power to enforce the Fourteenth Amendment to define, as a matter of law, that all human beings are persons from conception. Unlike a constitutional amendment, the HLB required only a majority vote in each House. President Reagan, newly elected in the 1980 landslide, was on record as supporting it. The HLB had momentum and there was a strong prospect that it could be enacted.

"At that point, however, the U.S. Catholic Conference, the lobbying arm of the Catholic bishops, and the National Right to Life Committee refused to support the HLB and threw their support instead to the Hatch Amendment. Not only was it clear at that time that there were insufficient votes in Congress to adopt *any* constitutional amendment restricting abortion, but the Hatch Amendment embodied the states' rights approach and was a repudiation of the personhood concept through which the pro-life movement had achieved increasing success.

"The Hatch Amendment controversy split the pro-life movement. Part of that movement remains receptive to the states' rights approach and to the allowance of abortion in 'exceptional' cases.

"There is no room in this matter for recriminations. And there is no point in disparaging those who follow the states' rights and 'exceptions' approach. They think it is the 'practical' course to accept some legalized abortion while trying to save some lives by enacting piecemeal protections. But that approach is not only wrong but futile and so is any pro-life movement which engages in such bargaining and brokering with the right to life."

Abuse of Underage Girls and Defrauding the Government

A Planned Parenthood clinic in Perth Amboy, NJ, was captured on film in a situation where two pro-lifers appeared, masquerading as a pimp and an underage teenage prostitute, seeking to access contraception, abortions, and sexually transmitted disease testing for underage prostitutes. The clinic manager pledged cooperation with the applicants and recommended that the prostitutes could get cheaper contraception by claiming that they were students.

This clinic of course simply facilitates statutory rape, in that it cooperates with the abortion of underage girls

without appropriate parental consent, which Planned Parenthood has been caught doing many times in the past, nationwide, on videotape, at multiple clinics.

Lila Rose, the 22-year-old young lady who heads Live Action (liveaction.org), states that they have uncovered PPH's facilitation of human sex trafficking involving 14 and 15-year-old girls in 10 PPH clinics nationwide over the past few years, and that state attorney generals' investigations are underway in several states. PPH receives \$343 million of federal tax funds annually.

But if people will kill, why are we surprised that they will lie?

Your first order of business for the new year should be a letter to your U.S. representatives and senators demanding the total and immediate revocation of all funding mechanisms for this evil. Northern Kentucky Congressman Geoff Davis (R) and the newly elected U.S. Senator from Kentucky, Dr. Rand Paul (R) have committed positions in response to NKRTL-PAC's questionnaire opposing the federal funding of such holocaust. U.S. Senator Mitch McConnell (R), Majority Leader of the U.S. Senate, has many times indicated his commitment to cutting the budget and removing all unnecessary wasteful expenditures (although he has not always answered our questionnaire). In light of the obvious awareness of the public electorate to the necessity for economic austerity, surely there can be no justification for continuing this publicly financed holocaust of innocent human beings?

One bill, **H.R. 5939, *No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act***, would establish a permanent ban on all federal funding for abortion or subsidizing by tax credits or tax deductions, and would prohibit funding of abortion overseas, in the District of Columbia, in federal prisons, and in coverage given to federal employees, and also establishes a federal conscience clause to guarantee that pro-life doctors, nurses, and hospitals never be forced to perform abortions or be discriminated against for refusing to do so.

H.R. 217, *Abortion Provider Prohibition*, prohibits any family and planning funds under Title X from going to PPH or any other organization that performs abortion.

Both bills have widespread support among Republican members in the House, and shrill opposition by the "Deathocrats." The mask has been stripped from the masqueraders! Stay tuned!

Please write to these individuals who have sought our votes to represent us in the U.S. Senate and the U.S. House of Representatives, and insist that they lend their names – as cosponsors – to these bills. How can these people in Congress reestablish their credibility if they do

not actively, publicly, and aggressively support such patently essential legislation?

THE DEMONIC MYTH OF OVER-POPULATION

In Europe, town squares are empty; in China, playground swings are empty; and in America, acres of homes are empty – and unsold.

These are just a few of the compelling images in the 2008 documentary, *Demographic Winter: the decline of the human family*, and its 2009 sequel, *Demographic Bomb: demography is destiny*.

Far from having too many people, the world is running out of them – especially young people.

Russia expects to lose a third of its population within 40 years, and is now offering \$9,000.00 to mothers for having a second child. Portugal's government is considering charging higher pension fees to those who have fewer than two children. Japan, which has the world's lowest birth rate outside of Europe (1.25 live births per woman), has a whole ministry devoted to reversing its decline.

The Population Bomb Scare

Not to worry, said **Paul Ehrlich**, a botanist who specialized in bees. He captured the attention of the American people with his book in the late 60s, *The Population Bomb*. He recommended reducing the population by the year 2025 "by intentional starvation." He was following the 19th Century British economist, Episcopal minister **Rev. Thomas Malthus**, who predicted that the human population would outgrow the food supply, and cause worldwide disaster – both of which have been proven to be dramatically, drastically, and demonically wrong. But the erroneous seed of their nefarious message has borne unfortunate progeny, as shown in *Demographic Winter*, which cites several factors contributing to the birth rate decline: rising prosperity, radical feminism, contraception, cohabitation, hedonism, and environmentalism, plus abortion.

However, in *Demographic Bomb*, **Dr. Matthew Connelly**, a Columbia University history professor, pointed out that both Malthus and Ehrlich erred by equating children with poverty: "What they are is more hands to help."

The United State is the only developed country with a replacement-level birth rate (2.13 children per woman). In *Demographic Winter*, **Harry S. Dent**, a well-known analyst of economic and demographic trends, explained that he accurately predicted the Japanese economic crash of 1990 by calculating when spending would peak for that country's baby boomers. He then predicted that the American crash would indeed happen soon thereafter, and which ties the real estate collapse that triggered the 2008 crash to the retirement of baby boomers, many of whom are leaving their three and four-bedroom homes to a

generation with families too small to want them and unable to buy them.

The historical, documented, and irrefutable teachings of these DVD's are worthy of viewing.

Malthus, 200 years ago, erroneously blamed poverty upon population growth. His philosophical child, Paul Ehrlich, in 1970 predicted that hundreds of millions will starve, which was proven erroneous by India gaining self-sufficiency in grain production in 1984.

In reality, history teaches quite to the contrary. Economic decline always follows the inverted pyramid of social support.

The United Nations' figures predict that by the year 2015 the number of aged people (60+) in North America will exceed children (15 years and under) for the first time in history, and that the total population will begin to decrease by the year 2040.

Abortion and Contraception Undermine Human Security

Currently, Congress collects about \$785 billion in **social security taxes** from about 163 million workers to send out \$585 billion to 50 million recipients. Social security trustees tell us that the surplus goes into a \$2.2 trillion trust fund to meet future obligations, but in reality the difference between social security taxes and benefits is actually spent by Congress.

According to social security trustee estimates, in the year 2016 the amount of social security benefits paid will exceed the taxes collected, which means that either Congress will raise taxes or slash promised benefits or both and that each year the situation will get worse since the number of retirees is predicted to increase relative to the number of workers paying taxes. In 1940, there were 42 workers per retiree, in 1950 there were 16, today there are 3, and in 20 or 30 years there will be 2 or fewer.

We see this very life-and-death struggle being waged now in the Congress between the secular materialists on the one hand and those who support the Judeo-Christian principle of the sanctity of all innocent human life, over the **Obama so-called "health care" legislation**. The first order of business by the new U.S. House of Representatives was a vote to repeal Obamacare, which passed by a vote on Party lines of 253 to 175. The House then directed four committees to draft legislation that would replace the legitimate features of the health care law, including portability, interstate-purchase ability, increased competition and choice, providing access thereby to affordable coverage for people with preexisting conditions, but eliminating the pro-euthanasia/pro-abortion/pro-bureaucracy takeover provisions contained in the Obama legislation. The road will be more difficult in the U.S. Senate, but **Sen. Mitch McConnell (R) of Kentucky**, Minority Party Leader there, has forced a recorded vote. The repeal lost 47-51, with all Republicans voting repeal and all "Deathocrats" voting to uphold the killing legislation. Accountability will be hung around the neck of those pro-death senators as they face the next biennial election.

U.S. Rep. John Boehner (R) of Ohio, newly elected Majority Leader of the U.S. House, has embraced a bill with other House Republican leaders stipulating that denial of federal money, subsidies, or tax credits for paying for any abortion or any health insurance plans that include coverage of abortion as "one of our highest legislative priorities."

Already, some Democratic senators had read the handwriting on the wall, and announced that they will not seek reelection, including **Max Baucus** of Montana and **Joe Lieberman** of Connecticut.

These stark realities were just confirmed by figures just released according to the January 27, 2011, *Cincinnati Enquirer* by the nonpartisan **Congressional Budget Office**, which pointed out that Social Security is sick and getting sicker and the trust funds will be totally depleted by the year 2037.

Very few wish to deal with the root causes, which are abortion and contraception. The mathematics of subtraction are really quite simple. However, the bottom line is the same – a massive Ponzi scheme, an illegal pyramid scheme named after Charles Ponzi, who duped thousands in the 20's, as money from new investors is used to pay off earlier investors until the whole scheme collapses – as replicated recently by the New York fraud, Bernie Madoff.

Can economic breakdown shock us back to moral sanity? God never ceases calling us back – but we may be at a moment of cataclysmic choice.

The Real Solution

Nobel Prize winner and *NY Times* columnist, **Paul Krugman**, a usually reliable liberal, slipped in letting the cat out of the bag in his ABC's "This Week," 11/19/2010): "WE'RE GOING TO GET THE REAL SOLUTION, WHICH IS GOING TO BE A COMBINATION OF DEATH PANELS AND SALES TAXES."

The long denied, but ineffectively disguised solution of the culture of death, woven into the Obamacare "health care" legislation, is undeniably euthanasia.

Your next priority should be a letter to President Obama, and to your senators and U.S. representatives demanding a repeal of the Obamacare death legislation which funds euthanasia and denies even the conscience rights of those in the health care community who oppose this holocaust.

OUR FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHT: A RESPONSIBILITY

This subject was addressed recently in an excellent article in the Fall issue of *Celebrate Life*, published by **American Life League**: “How did it happen in Germany that so many ordinary people averted their eyes from the wickedness going on all around them? How did they fail to recognize the humanity of the millions of Holocaust victims? When the death camp ovens were ignited, the smoke blew over neighboring towns and villages. Daily, their residents would witness the trains arriving laden with new internees – and always leaving empty. How did they not know what was happening in those camps? Why did they not act to stop it?”

Future generations will ask the same questions of Americans who lived in the latter part of the 20th Century, regarding the abortion holocaust whose victims are three times as many as those of the Nazi holocaust, and whose killings are widely publicized, advertised, and indeed subsidized with taxpayers’ dollars! Why is there such apathy on the part of so many Americans?

Political Correctness

The answer is because of the timidity of too many people, including political and church leaders, to stand up and exercise our First Amendment freedom of expression, in defense of innocent human life, and to encourage others to do the same. While there is no threat (at least for the present) that we would be hustled off to prison for such conduct, we certainly would suffer social ostracism in many circles.

That very message was reiterated in a recent homily delivered by **Fr. Michael Cordier** at the December 18, 2010, liturgy of **Helpers of God’s Precious Infants**, which celebrates Mass four Saturdays a month in Cincinnati, followed by peaceful prayer procession to the nearby abortuary.

Fr. Cordier advised the assembled pro-lifers that recently his sister advised him that a friend of hers commented about Fr. Cordier, “He just preaches about abortion far too much!” Father pointed out to those assembled:

“I am sure that, as dedicated pro-life Christians who make sacrifices to come out to pray and witness to the sanctity of human life, even in the cold and the snow that you can relate to that. I am sure that many of you have friends, neighbors, coworkers, even sadly fellow parishioners, who accuse you of being obsessed with abortion, or unbalanced, or one-track or single-issue. ...

“During Advent, our Scripture readings emphasize God’s justice, and in a very particular way, justice for the poor. ...

“Who could possibly be considered *more* poor, *more* afflicted, *more* lowly than the unborn child in the womb, whose life is threatened with extinction for no good reason? The sick and the elderly and the handicapped of course always deserve our consideration, but even they have the gift of life – as long as we defend it. We have allowed the unborn to have that snatched away.

“It is literally the gravest of injustices imaginable to tolerate and even enable, as our American society does, the wholesale killing of untold thousands of children in the womb. Year in, year out. Often to be greeted merely with an indifferent shrug,

even – so sadly – by people sitting next to us in our own pews on Sundays – who say, in effect, yes I am pro-life, but it is time to move on to so-called ‘more important’ things. I’ve already heard this message before.

“I will say this very directly: Are there other injustices out there? Of course. The Church continues to address them in every sphere of life, whether it is unjust treatment of immigrants, unfair treatment of peoples based on their race or sex, disparities in the care of people based on social class and so on. But all of these utterly pale in the degree of violation of justice when compared to the arbitrary and capricious killing of 1/3 of the brothers and sisters in our human family, who are given no right to live merely because they are deemed inconvenient, or treated as chattel property belonging to a mother to dispose of, often at the hands of a cruel abortionist.

“When people complain they we are too focused on resolving this kind of injustice then there are really only two possibilities: (1) they simply don’t understand what God’s justice means, or (2) they are indifferent to it. So as pro-life Christians, we have to do both: educate people on what justice is, and work and pray for their conversion so that their hearts will no longer be hardened against the plight of the poor and the vulnerable whom our dear Lord loves so much. In fact, whom He came first and foremost to save.

“We have to proclaim the truth over and over again, in season and out, that there is simply no possibility to build a just society until we can right this fundamental wrong. We who are Christians seeking to hasten the Advent of Christ in our own place of time are keenly aware that the fulness of His coming can’t be realized if we are indifferent to His demand to work for justice.”

The Church includes as a Spiritual Work of Mercy the duty of each of us to “admonish the sinner.”

The Consequences of Silence

In America, we have never experienced a dictatorship as Germany did, points out the *Celebrate Life* article, but we are experiencing our own holocaust. Many of the smallest and most vulnerable citizens are meeting untimely deaths at an alarming rate. We are privileged to live in a country where speech is still free. But if we refuse to speak up because we are fearful or embarrassed, we will soon lose our right to do so. And then it will be much harder to save anyone.

In the physical realm, muscles shrink from disuse. In the civic realm, rights are lost through non-exercise. In the spiritual realm, souls shrivel from apathy. “Use it or lose it!”

“SAFE AND LEGAL,” OR “HOUSE OF HORRORS”???

“When I said no, the doctor got upset and he ended up taking my clothes off, hitting me, my legs were tied to the stirrups...I just remember my very last thought ... looking up at the light and thinking, ‘Don’t fall asleep,’” related Robyn Reid to ABC News about when her grandmother brought the then-three-months-pregnant 15-year-old to Dr. Kermit Gosnell’s facility in January, 1998. As reported by lifesitenews.com, Reid said the drugs Gosnell gave her were so strong they knocked her out for 12 hours.

In January, Kermit Gosnell, 69, a family practice physician, who had no certification in gynecology or obstetrics, was arrested and indicted for murder in the death of Karnamaya Mongar and seven counts of murder for killing seven living infants. Along with him, nine other employees, including his wife, were also arrested and indicted.

It was only after a raid on the facility for a drug bust that authorities discovered this “house of horrors” and how gruesome was this abortion mill which had been operating for the last 30 years.

The grand jury report criticized **National Abortion Federation**, whose staff member did not report the violation she witnessed at Gosnell’s abortion mill in 2009.

During a press conference, the Philadelphia District Attorney, **R. Seth Williams**, a Democrat, said Gosnell “induced labor, forced the live birth of viable babies in the sixth, seventh, eighth month of pregnancy, and then killed those babies by cutting into the back of the neck with scissors and severing their spinal cord.”

The grand jury reported that a 15-year-old high school student administered intravenous anesthetic and that **Pearl Gosnell**, the abortionist’s wife, a cosmetologist, performed late-term abortions.

When the police arrested Gosnell at his home, they discovered \$240,000 in cash.
