Being in your office there at the former St. Pius X Seminary brings back fond memories: seminarians printing our newsletter, Bishop Ackerman offering Mass for NKRTL, and our being afforded the opportunity to speak on these issues to all of the priests of the diocese.

We look forward to working with you, as faithful sons and daughters of the Church, in advancing the truths taught by Jesus Christ.
