## PRO-LIFE BILL DEFEATED - AGAIN BY PRO-ABORT DEMOCRATS IN THE KENTUCKY LEGISLATURE

**S**enator Jack Westwood (R) of Northern Kentucky introduced a bill which would require physicians to perform ultrasounds and present the images to pregnant women seeking abortions, as well as require a person-to-person consultation between the doctor and the woman 24 hours in advance of the abortion. The bill was passed overwhelmingly by the Kentucky State Senate, and then bottled up in the House Judiciary Committee, chaired by strident pro-abortion **Representative Kathy Stein (D) of Lexington**, a strong leader of the “pro-choice” movement, which continues to deny to the pregnant women information upon which to base a sound choice.

The usual games were played, delaying the bill until late in the session, with promises by Chairwoman Stein that she was going to permit her committee to give the bill a hearing, but then an announcement late in the session by her stated that she and the “Democratic leadership of the House” decided that the bill needed more work and that it had to be referred for further study, denying it a hearing in the Committee, and denying the bill a floor vote in the House. The reality of course is that she was giving protection to the pro-abortion Democrats in the House, so that they didn’t have to cast a pro-death vote of record, and complicit in this usual charade of deception and affront to the Democratic process was the Democratic “leadership” in the House, i.e., the speaker, the majority leader, etc., all of whom are elected by the Democratic members of the House.

The next time that your friends in the Democratic Party tell you that they are Pro-Life, but they are voting for a Democratic member to the legislature, what you need to remind them of is that what you get when you elect Democrats — predicably and guaranteed — is more dead babies!

**T**he Ethics Committee of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology

has stepped up its aggression against Pro-Life physicians by issuing an opinion that physicians’ conduct may be deemed “unethical” if they do not perform abortions or refer patients desiring an abortion to an abortion provider. Sic transit “freedom of choice”! **Bishop Elio Sgreccia, President of the Pontifical Academy for Life**, has reiterated its previous stated position that the morning-after pill cannot be used even in cases of rape, and may never be administered by Catholic physicians – which is contrary to the current practice authorized in Catholic hospitals in Kentucky by the four bishops of that state.

The tip of the iceberg of sexual abuse of minors, with the criminal complicity of **Planned Parenthood**, has just been exposed in two recent pending cases. One involved the rape of a child by her parent from age 13 until 18, including his taking her to Planned Parenthood for an abortion at age 16. Planned Parenthood did the abortion even though the child told them that it was her father who was forcing her to have sex, but they aborted her and returned her home to be raped by her father again and again for the next two years. The father is now serving a prison sentence and the girl is suing Planned Parenthood, which of course denies any knowledge – even though it is the law of every state that the pregnancy of such a minor constitutes statutory rape and that anyone coming into knowledge of that is obliged to report it to the state prosecutorial authorities.

The second case involved the rape of a 13-year-old by her soccer coach, who then forced her to get an abortion, and Planned Parenthood administered Depo Provera and sent her home to be raped again.

Planned Parenthood is definitely afraid of course, not only of the damages in these cases but also the fact that it will be required to divulge its patient records showing how many criminal violations they have participated in,

aborting minors, whose very pregnancy constitutes evidence of a state criminal act, and must be reported, which of course they did not.
